HARRISBURG, Pa. WRA served as the prime consultant and provided preliminary engineering, final design, and construction consultation services for this design, bid and build project in PennDOT District 11-0. The existing, structurally deficient single-span bridge carried State Route 0208 (Pulaski Road) over Deer Creek in Pulaski Township along a tangent alignment. The project site is in a rural area with the Rolling Hills Golf Course located immediately adjacent to the bridge on both sides of State Route 0208.

After evaluating the alternatives, WRA proposed that the replacement spread box beam superstructure be constructed off alignment and slid laterally into place onto precast integral abutments during a five-day road closure. Due to the effective schedule, the roadway was opened to traffic five hours ahead of schedule.
