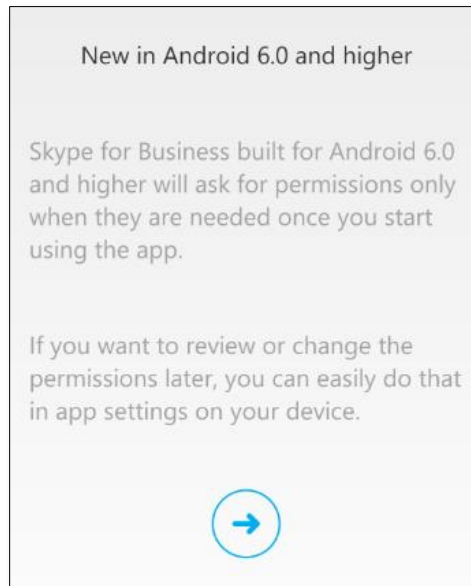
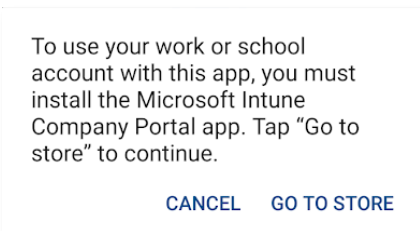



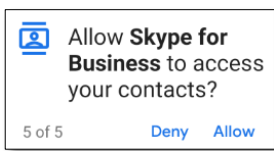
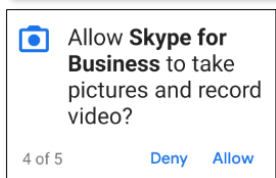
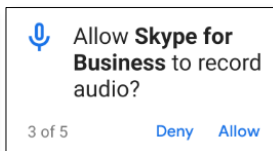
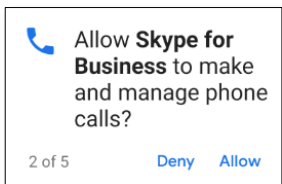
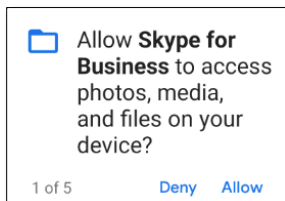
Installation instructions – Skype for Business on an Android Device

1. Install the official **Skype for Business** mobile app from the [Google Play store](#).
2. Depending on the version of the Android operating system that you are running, you may see the following messages


3. If prompted to install the Microsoft Intune Company Portal, this is OK to proceed. Follow the onscreen prompts and install from Google Play store




4. Click the  to continue with the setup.
5. You will be prompted to Allow Access to photos, phone calls, audio, or access to contacts on your device.



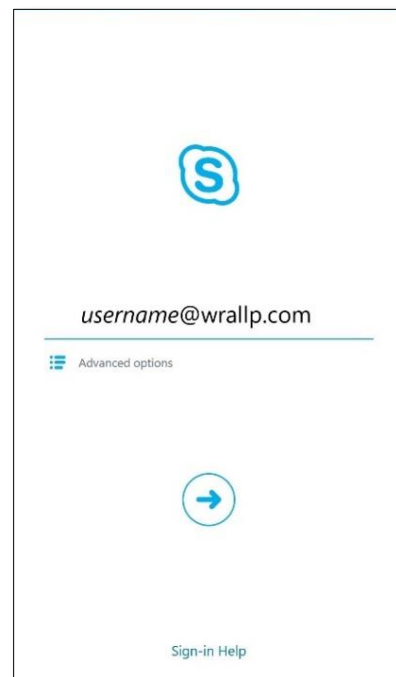
6. Review and Accept Terms of Use

8. Enter your WRA email address. Then click the  to continue

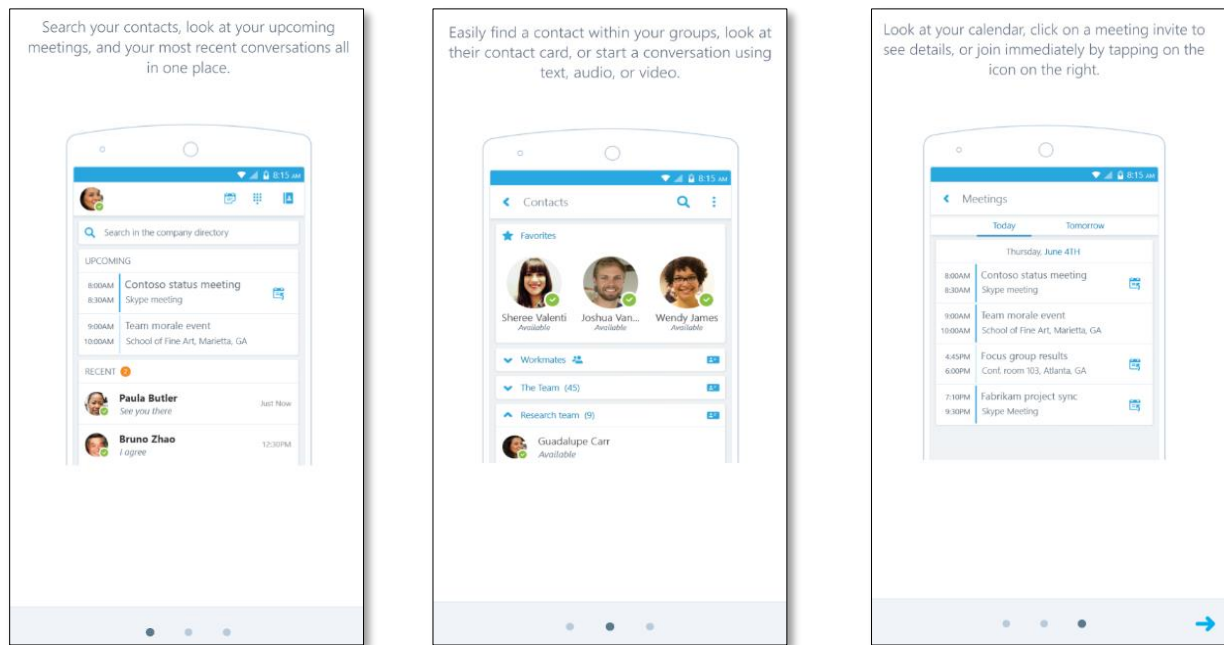
9. Enter your WRA network password.

10. Enter/Confirm your mobile phone number. This will allow you to make and receive Skype calls from your cell phone.

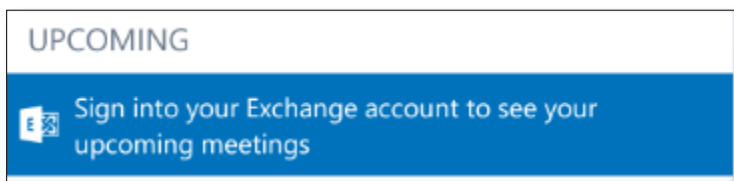


11. Click the  to sign-in
